We ask the foster to schedule and take their dog to veterinary appointments as well as to review their applications, perform home visits and finalize the adoptions. You'll need to use a computer. Lap Dog Rescue provides all veterinary care, food, supplies and even the collar or harness that the little one sports.

We have a cadre of experienced fosters to help new fosters through the process of getting a dog ready for adoption. We can offer tips for everything from house-training to helping a shy dog who has never known a gentle hand learn to trust.

When your foster dog finds that perfect home, your goodbyes will be tough but knowing that a dog has found their "forever" home and that another homeless pet awaits your tender care makes it all worthwhile.
